Tony Crook is former Senior Pro-Vice Chancellor of The University of Sheffield and Emeritus Professor of Town & Regional Planning.

He is Deputy Chair of the Orbit Housing Group; a member of the RTPI Trustee Board, chairing its Education Committee; chairs the review of governance in Rotherham; and is on the Housing Commission for Northern England. Recent former non executive roles include: chair of Shelter Trustee Board; Coalfields Regeneration Trust trustee; Academy of Social Sciences council member; Sheffield Homes Ltd chair; and Lloyds Banking Group Housing Commission member.

His current research includes private renting and planning obligations. His latest books are 'Private rental housing: comparative perspective' (Edward Elgar) and 'Planning Gain: providing infrastructure and affordable housing' (Wiley Blackwell) the latter winning the RTPI Research Excellence Award in 2016.

In 2004 he was elected as a Fellow of the Academy of Social Sciences and was appointed CBE in the 2014 New Year Honours for services to housing.
